	<ul><li>June begin setting steel</li><li>Sept/October begin enclosing of building.</li></ul>
	Cass County Electric will have to pull a transformer for new construction. This could affect the power in Colfax for up to eight hours. This can be avoided by moving the transformer. Cass County Electric will give 500 feet free after that it is \$20,000-\$30,000. There is a \$9,000 allotment built into the budget.
	McGough will begin billing the Foundation for Construction costs at the end of each month. The first bill will be at the end of April.
